## Still Life\*

\*Bring in a favorite still life item you'd like to paint, or use one I provide.

Demos and guided instruction in basic watercolor techniques.

Improve your skills, have fun, and push your limits to paint a beautiful watercolor to take home!

### Materials

***If you are new to watercolor and don't have materials yet, don't worry! I provide them all for you. More experienced painters may want to bring your own. Some suggestions:***

**5 - 6 watercolor brushes:** a 3/4" and 1" flat wash; and #6, #8, and #10, round brushes, minimum

**Watercolor Paper:** 4 or 5 sheets of 9x12 w/c paper such as Arches or Canson, etc. (get the best your can afford).

**Paints:** 8 - 10 tube watercolor paints - I use mostly Daniel Smith & Graham. Suggested: cerulean blue, cobalt blue, ultramarine blue, thalo blue, azo yellow, hansa yellow deep, new gamboge, burnt sienna, quinacridone sienna, cadmium red, quinacridone red, carbazole violet, hooker's green, cascade green, green gold

**A Palette:** You need a large white plastic palette w/ paint wells and ample mixing area in center, or enamel butcher tray.

**Other items :** a sketchbook, a soft pencil, gum or kneaded eraser, masking tape, support board, tissue, paper towels, water spritzer
